

Robert M. "Big Wizard" Archer, a CCM member since the early 90's, succumbed to pancreatic cancer last year. Robbie graduated from McClatchy High School, winning the Sacramento Raceway High School Drags Season Points in his senior year.

He served in the U.S. Marines as a helicopter Crew Chief, and after his service operated a High Performance 4-WD Shop, competing in many off-road events, later became a construction supervisor for a Defense Contractor where he worked around the world, including many trips to Iraq and Afghanistan.

Robert served as ceremonial Fire Keeper for the Owl Creek Sundance on the Cheyenne River Reservation. He is sorely missed by his parents, (father Steve Archer is a current CCM member) and extended family in the Native American Community.


